GREETINGS EVERYONE!

Club membership as of June 22nd stands at 84 members.

ACTIVITIES AT THE FIELD:

No new News to report other than plenty of hot weather to go around for everyone.

May General Meeting Notes:

Jack presented the June Treasurer's Report and reviewed what came in and all the expenses for the month. The high amount of income as you can see is the great response we had for membership renewals. See attached report.

CLUB OFFICER ELECTIONS: During our previous May meeting nominations were made to re-elect the existing Club officers. No new nominations for 2024/2025 Club Officers were submitted at the June meeting. A motion was made and seconded to approve the nomination that all of the existing Club officers be re-elected for another one-year term. The vote was unanimous.

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL: We have had an outstanding response for Club membership renewals during the month of June. As noted above we have at least 84 renewals and I am sure there are several that are in the mail that we have not accounted for. So what that means is we are getting close to reaching our cap of 100 memberships. Some of you have contacted me indicating they could not remember if they sent it in or not. Trust me, I get it. Don't hesitate to contact me to check and see if we have received it or not. I am more than happy to check it out.

GATE KEY CHANGE????: In one of my previous emails, I indicated that we were talking about the possibility of changing out the gate key. The officers decided that based on the great response of membership renewals it will not be necessary. So, with that said, if you haven't renewed yet and are planning to please renew in the next week or please mail us back your gate key. We will be going through the list of those who haven't renewed and will reach out to you in about a week to confirm your intentions. Again, please contact me if you have any questions. Thank you.

JULY CLUB MEETING: Just a reminder to all that we are planning to hold our July 24th Club meeting at the flying field. That way some of you can possibly get a little flying in before or right after the meeting weather permitting. Also, it will be a good time to bring your large aircraft for Show & Tell that you would not necessarily want to bring to Mimi's!

Reminder: As most of you know any aircraft that uses Lipo type batteries, electric or gas, has a potential risk of starting a fire if involved in a serious enough crash that would damage the Lipo battery pack. Because we are in a high risk fire zone and given the vegetation is extremely dry we insist any pilot that is involved in such a crash needs to take action immediately and get to the crash site as soon as possible to prevent or put out any flames.

SEPTEMBER FLOAT FLY: Currently we are still planning on having a Fun Float Fly event on Saturday, September 28th from 8 AM to 3 PM weather permitting. So far, we have about 16 members who said they will be participating plus we will send out an invitation to several of the surrounding clubs. I am currently waiting for AMA to get back to me to see if we have to have remote ID's or any other requirements. Currently our FRIA site boundaries do not include the lower lagoon where we will be flying but because we lease from the Dept. of Parks and Recreation that controls the lagoon we are hoping to add that area temporarily for this event. So, before I can give you a 100% go for this event I am hoping to work out all the details with AMA by early next week and will let you know as soon as possible.

FUEL UPDATE:

If you wish to purchase more fuel, just contact one of the Club officers and we can help you. Last count we had 9 gallons of 15% and three gallons of 10%. Our costs for the new batch of 15% went up, so we had to raise the club member price to \$40 per gallon. That is still \$5 less than what Smith Bros. is selling it for, plus you don't have to drive down there to pick it up. We are selling the remaining three gallons of 10% for \$35. Please bring the correct change for your fuel as we do not keep change at the field.

SHIRTS, AND SWEATSHIRTS:

We now have great-looking polo shirts in stock. We also have Tee shirts and sweatshirts and hats available at the field. They are all looking good! The cost is \$35 for Polos, \$20.00 for tee shirts and hats and \$40.00 for sweatshirts. See a club officer for yours.
